ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

All paper submissions will be handled electronically. The server will be open for submissions starting on January 15, 2005. Submissions will be accepted until 11.59 pm on February 28, 2005 (extended deadline).

The conference is using the <u>EDAS</u> Conference Management System to manage paper submissions. Submission is a two-step process: first you register your paper with EDAS. Step 1 - Abstract Registration

1). An abstract summarizing an original work (even in progress) must be electronically registered at the following address:

- 2). Complete in details the <u>form</u> (e-mail of the authors, title of the paper, etc...). Please, choose from the given lists 3 topics in order of importance for your paper. As these will be used to match papers to reviewers. Click on the "submit information" button to register you paper.
- 3). If you have not submitted a paper before, you will be asked for your name and other contact information.
- 4). EDAS will automatically send you an e-mail to confirm your submission. This mail also gives you a register number and a procedure for the abstract submission of step2.

Step 2 - Abstract Submission

The paper must be in PDF format. No other formats will be accepted. The cover page must include:

- the title of the paper
- authors' names and affiliations
- contact author's name and address (both postal and electronic)
- keywords and submission area (from the list of relevant areas of interest)

- 1) You now need to upload your paper on the ITST 2005 conference ftp server. All the instructions have been sent via e-mail (at the end of the step 1).
- 2) EDAS will automatically send you an e-mail to confirm your final paper submission after about fifteen minutes to an hour.
